ment and execution of Naperville CARES' Cuisine for a Cause and Toasting for a Cause — Karen has chaired six years for Cuisine and Toasting four. The events net CARES over \$100,000 annually.

For The Rotary Club of Naperville, she has coordinated the catering for 16 years of Oktoberfest and

Soup's On! was born. Hosed House, Loaves & Fishes and DuPage PADS are the event's beneficiaries. Since 2008, the Rotary club has given \$164,000 to these not-for-profits.
